Dear Adopt- A-Spot Participants,

Keep Arlington Beautiful (KAB), in association with the Arlington Parks Department announced a campaign for the removal of litter from public right-of-ways such as parks, streets, and trails in June 2015. KAB received \$2,000 in grant funding from H-E-B and the Central Market's Green Bag Grants to aid in developing an Adopt-A-Spot program for Arlington.

The pilot program funding was utilized to kick-start the initiative with intent for organizations, businesses, teams, and families to come together in the beautification of the Arlington. The program made available to 20 areas within Council District No. 1, has completed its first year of operations.

KAB had aspirations to expand the program to the City at large. With recent evaluation of the program, the department/Board has determined that the current program structure, administration impacts, and volunteer obligation is unsustainable. The City will be phasing the program out over the months ahead, including removal of the signs. The participant signs will be made available to you upon request.

Thank you again for participating in the pilot program with Keep Arlington Beautiful. Although this opportunity for service has dissolved, there are still many volunteer opportunities available with our organization. We certainly enjoyed working with you and appreciate your efforts.
